The former Copper Lounge building collapsed December 2 in downtown Sioux Falls during renovation. Rescue crews worked to rescue Emily Fodness and construction worker, Ethan McMahon. Unfortunately McMahon died, but Fodness and her three dogs survived. Another company was remodeling the building into a Lewis Drug store.

Some members of our Henry Carlson Company crew offered their assistance during this tragedy. Henry Carlson Construction donated heavy equipment from the Washington Square site to help stabilize the building and clear rubble.

# City Administration Building Groundbreaking Ceremony

The City of Sioux Falls held their groundbreaking ceremony January 9 for the new City Administration Building. The \$21.9 million project includes the construction of a three-story building - two finished stories, a third-story shell, footings and foundations for a future fourth floor, underground parking and storage. The project budget will allow investments to improve Van Eps Park and Dakota Avenue in downtown Sioux Falls.
