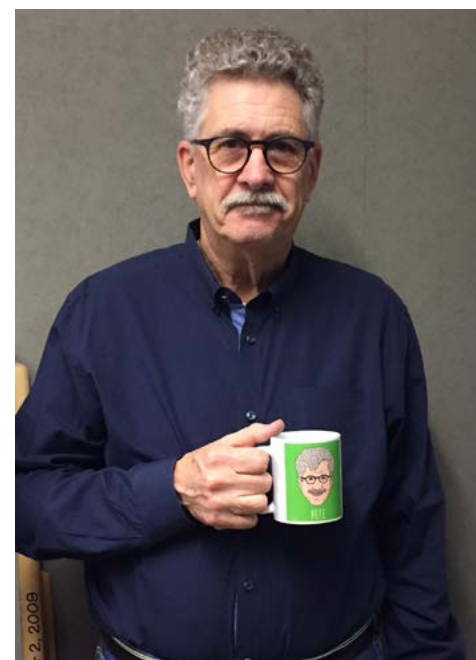

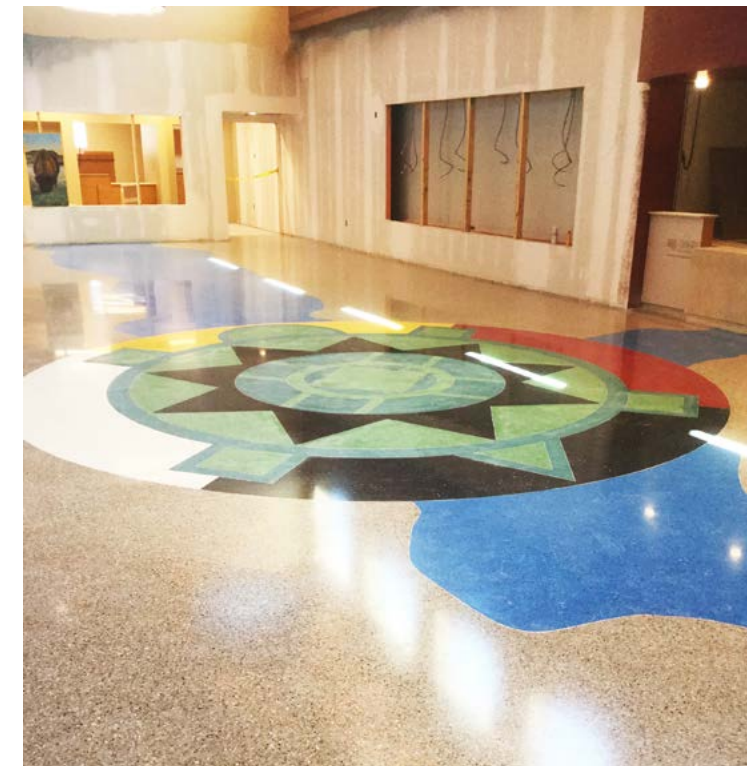

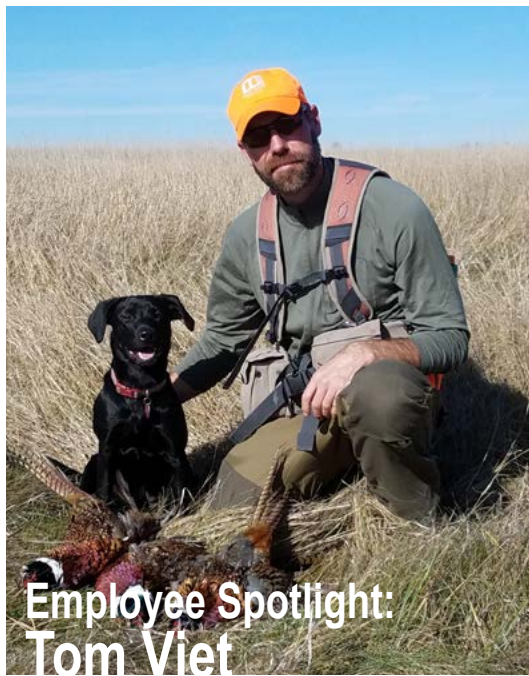
Julie Nelson, Senior Vice President Business Development for American Bank & Trust and LSF graduate, will address the graduates and their guests.
