## **3M Aberdeen announces expansion**

Henry Carlson Construction, along with Kyburz-Carlson Construction have been awarded the 3M project expansion project in Aberdeen. Duke Brosonski, JD Bechina and John Gliko are stationed in Aberdeen for the project.



Aberdeen's 3M facility will be adding 120,000 square feet to expand production of N95 masks.

The expansion is needed because 3M was awarded two U.S. Department of Defense contracts to further expand its U.S. production of N95 respirators.

Those new contracts mean, in part, the construction of two new wings creating a combined 120,000-square-foot expansion to its Aberdeen plant, according to a news release from the company.

An east and west wing, each 60,000 square feet, will be

added to the south side of the current facility, which currently spans 440,000 square feet. The first wing is expected to be up in the next 90 days, said Aberdeen plant manager Andy Rehder. An additional 100 employees will be added to staff the new equipment with hiring continuing through the next two to three months, he said.

Rehder expects the expansion's impact on Aberdeen will include: continued job opportunities, work for local contractors helping with the expansion and use of hotel rooms for 3M employees and contractors.

## JT Thomas retires after 43 years at HCC


JT Thomas retired from Henry Carlson Construction in April after 43 years of service.



# First PREMIER Bank Update

Field Engineer Matt Kolbeck updates us on the progress at First PREMIER Bank's corporate office.

At the First PREMIER Bank project, we are currently installing the parking structure foundation walls at the northeast corner of the property. Lynde Construction will be placing the first section of wall this week. Excavation of the south foundation walls will begin this week as well.

For the building proper, the exterior curtain wall system is framed and glazed on almost all of the south, west and north elevations with the east side starting soon. Sands Drywall has walls framed on the south half of the building up to the fifth floor and will progress to the north side from fifth floor down to first. The MEP rough-ins are following nicely behind the framers.

On the roof, the framers have completed the halo roof system and the Henry Carlson Construction decking crew has a little decking left to complete on the halo system. Both penthouses are framed and sheeted and the south has a roof on it. The roofer is continuing roofing on the south side of the main roof this week.
