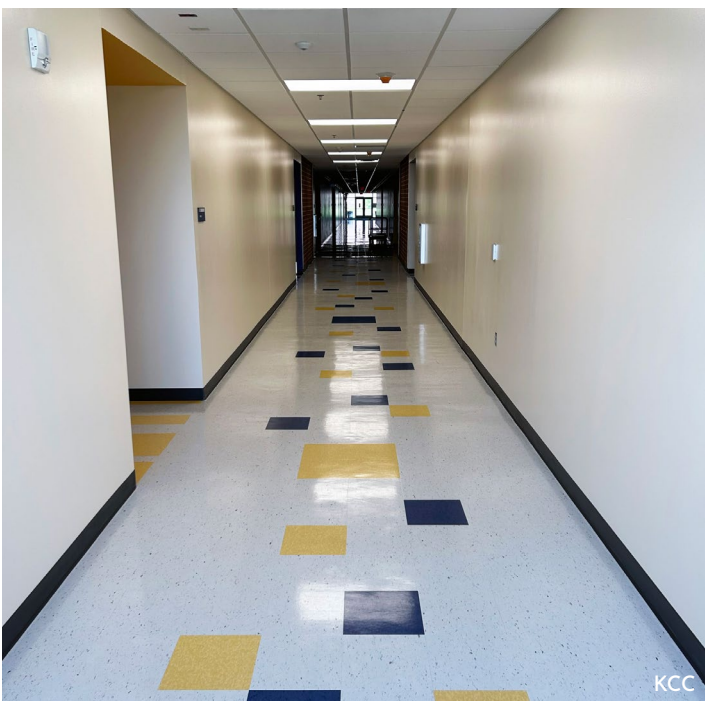
ATEC Project at Aberdeen Central High School

A family and consumer sciences classroom for the non-food-related courses like child development, interior design and fashion. An added computer lab that will also double as a space for the e-sports team and a computer gaming club. Along with a networking and broadcast studio for the production of a televised student media program.

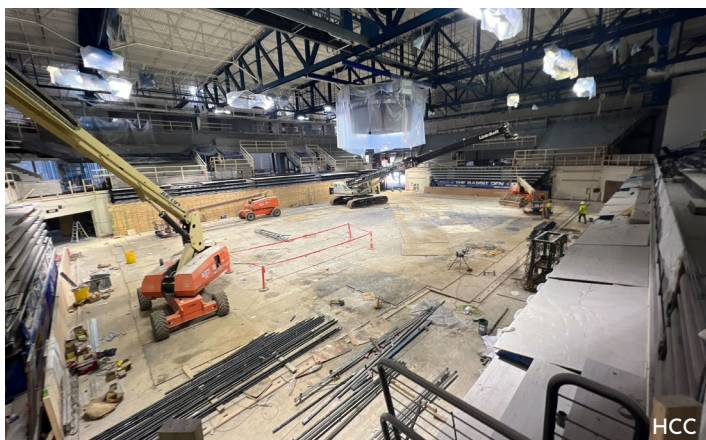

Columbia Park & Ballfield: Thirteen acre park and ballfield. Site features include: two small buildings for restrooms and concessions, park shelters, picnic tables, benches, pickleball court, basketball court, disc golf course, two playgrounds, lighted pathways, ballfield lighting, Agri-lime infield with underdrains, dugouts, batting cage, bleachers, scoreboard, paved parking lot, guardrails and fencing. Three new wells and two iron filter systems supply the water to irrigate the entire site.



Sioux Falls Airport Parking Ramp Update: This week, the level two deck placements of the parking ramp will be finished, and the focus will shift towards the placement of the third level deck. Last week, we successfully completed phase one of the alternate #1 roof reinforcement, which has now been handed over to the owner. Currently, we are working on reinforcing two more bays of the roof while simultaneously carrying out the demolition of the main entrance. In the upcoming weeks, we will commence excavations and lay foundations for the future terminal lobby.

LG Everist Nine Mile Update: The PEMB panels are being skinned onto the Batch Plant at 37 feet high. The Raeco concrete crew has completed the placement at the batch plant mezzanine, and now MEP services are working on the second-floor mezzanine.

HCC self-perform steel has achieved substantial completion of the aggregate materials building and the primary conveyor connecting the aggregate building to the batch plant building. Castlerock Concrete has finished working at the concrete truck wash and is currently working on forming and placing the concrete washout/aggregate building and starting the entrances soon.

Select Painting continues to paint both interior and exterior areas up to a height of 51 feet. First Rate is currently backfilling the concrete truck washout area and excavating the north and south main entrances, including the monument signage. Yellowjacket has successfully installed 160 trees and most of the boulders, except for those at the north and south entrances.

Lastly, Malloy Electric is in the process of installing high voltage conduits for the batch plant and over 30 cobra poles throughout the entire civil site.



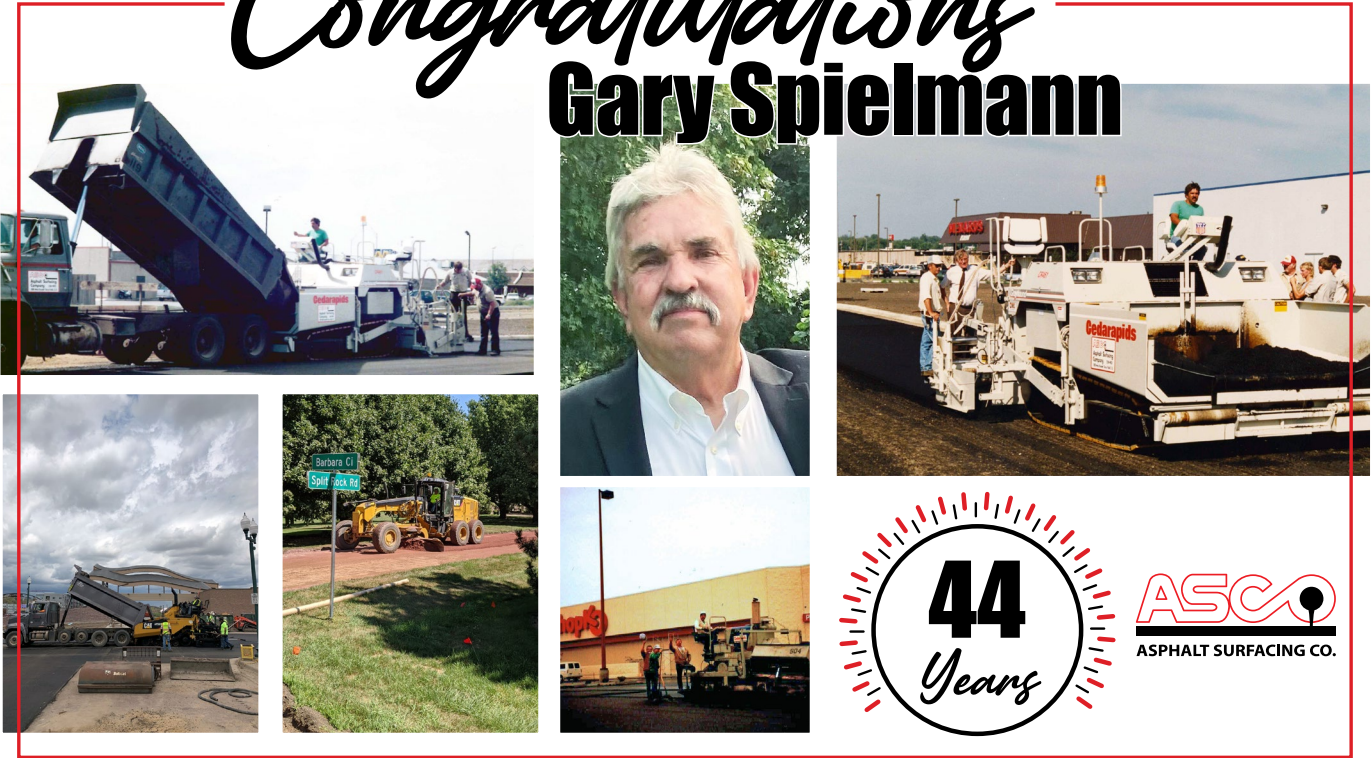
