



The framing and MEP rough-ins for the new concessions and bathrooms around the second floor bowl is ongoing. The remodeled north lobby, concessions and restrooms are nearly complete.

Finishes are ongoing in the new coach's offices. We are hanging sheetrock in the new team room area. The new southwest student entrance footings are poured with steel erection scheduled to begin shortly.



HCC Sioux Falls Regional Airport Parking Ramp Update from Field Engineer Blaid Friedrichs: The FSD Airport parking ramp is progressing day by day. We have just 10 post-tensioned concrete placements remaining to complete the ramp's structure. In the coming months, we'll start installing the precast skin of the ramp and precast for the lobby.

The roof reinforcement for Alternate #1 is finished, and we're now working on the alternate lobby. We've placed half of the footings, and backfilling is underway. Due to limited space, we're executing this in two phases. Once the first half of backfilling is done, we'll complete the remaining footings and underground work. Following this, we'll begin steel erection and precast installation.










## **Monthly Webstore**
